Eduardo Diaz:@TT I can add not only newbies but also those that want to refresh their understanding about how ICANN works .

Keith Drazek:thanks sandra and avri, appreciate your responses. it will be important to ensure the faculty presents/discusses the various views and perspectives from within the community, particularly on the substantive topics of the day. i can anticipate a concern that such an influential thing as the icann academy could be used to promote one view over another, etc. if balance isn't ensured through the selection process.

TT:@Eduardo exactly why i said at least/ minimum once

Keith Drazek:i support the concept of the icann academy

Sandra Hoferichter:@Keith absolutely!

Glenn McKnight:We need to start somewhere, we can't be perfect but the goals are pure

Glenn McKnight: Important that the training be simple, adult oriented not boring

Cheryl Langdon-Orr: and it (the effectiveness and fairness etc.,) of the faculty would surely be subject to feedback and review processes to ensure this as well

Dev Anand Teelucksingh: Q: Re: getting AC/SO leaders presenting at the ICANN Academy a few days before the main ICANN meeting, how feasible is this for AC/SO chairs to arrive the Tuesday or Wednesday the week before the main ICANN meeting?

Glenn McKnight: The logistics issue needs to be addressed

Eduardo Diaz: Yes, that is what I meant as a student.

TT: @ All need to send my apologies need to focus on next phase of work. In general yes I do agree and the Academy has my full support. Specifics to be ironed out as we plan in days ahead is ensuring the faculty is drawn from within the community - mindful of individual perspectives of course while balanced with having external expertise that helps to shed light on perceptions of ICANN and its role from outside our walled walls. Second: Content: should be locally relevant as much as it is international, should be far from just technicalities but be enough of a foundation to help develop/strengthen community should not shy away from controversial comments/topics :-)

Cheryl Langdon-Orr: Thanks TT

TT: Last; issue of cost: alternative funding models not drawing only from ICANN - possibility to find specific support from constituency (hmm diacy - influencers eh!)

TT: Cheers all!

Wolf Ludwig: Thanks Avri for the clarification. @Eduardo: For broader At-Large and RALO community there are other Capacity building programs ...

Hong Xue: I agree with Tijana.

Sivasubramanian M: And there is always something to unlearn

Cheryl Langdon-Orr: thinking about how even experienced ICANNers are still very silo based OR MAY be

Glenn McKnight: This is why the PEER to PEER mentoring is important

Glenn McKnight: Many people might be available but they might be really poor facilitators

Glenn McKnight: It would be helpful to do a tight video edit of chairs etc with specific questions so it fits into the courseware
