[Universal Acceptance](#) is key to achieving a digitally inclusive Internet by ensuring that all domain names and email addresses – regardless of script, language or character length – are accepted equally by all Internet-enabled applications, devices, and systems. This includes supporting all [new and long generic top-level domains](#) (gTLDs), and [Internationalized Domain Names](#) (IDNs) including both the IDN [country code top-level domains](#) (ccTLDs) and gTLDs.
