Fouad Bajwa:sorry community interest that is in my question

Fouad Bajwa:thanks for correction between public and community interests

Fouad Bajwa:maybe we also include a point in our document about looking at this cross IO and ALAC objections?

CLO:Yes I agree with the limitation of the costs resources (token or otherwise) we have to be able to justify what we do or do not support as objections in any round

Fouad Bajwa:I do think that the objection process remains a weak link but at the same time ALAC has the opportunity to build a strong process by building a scoring list. The ALAC process that may be established here will require a great degree of mobilization of ALAC and its outreach on the subject.

Fouad Bajwa:scoring list would be again a blind link but i think if we start at this stage we can devise such a list of possible objection areas

Fouad Bajwa:i'm in a noisy place

Fouad Bajwa:so i can type here

Fouad Bajwa:i think we may need to show a certain number of issues that can be used for objections

Fouad Bajwa:to our ALSS

CLO:it could become a logistical NIGHTMARE if we are not careful of course

Fouad Bajwa:and then give a call to RALOs'

Fouad Bajwa:to share their concerns or comments on devising or enhancing such a list

CLO:ecime = BECOME

Fouad Bajwa:@avri, yeup

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:page 167 speaks the Limited Public Interest Objection

Fouad Bajwa:i know its a new exercise for all of us

Fouad Bajwa:but we will learn in the process

Fouad Bajwa:yeah, dsrp, how do we understand the grounds

Fouad Bajwa:thats the missing link

CLO:Absolutely Dev that is a must perhaps we can start with a discussion of p 167 and DRSP next week some of us have hot buttoins and memories on all this of course ;-)

Cintra Sooknanan:MOPO is tough to define

Fouad Bajwa:MOPO?

CLO:YUP *shudder*

Cintra Sooknanan:morality and public order

Evan Leibovitch:MAPO - "Morality And Public Order"

Fouad Bajwa:i don't think that could really ever be defined
Fouad Bajwa:it will remain a more cultural kind of thing
Evan Leibovitch:ICANN insists on providing a mechanism to object on this basis. This battle has been fought and lost

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:Interestingly, "National laws notbased on principles of international law are not a validground for a Limited Public Interest objection."
Fouad Bajwa:this is so cultural, regional, differing from state to state etc

Fouad Bajwa:because with a unilateral scope, sometimes multilateral issues don't recieve MAPO reconsiderations ;)

Carlos Dionisio Aguirre:Dear Fouad: I think you touched the magic word: Outreach , because I have a deep concern about how we can avoid the possibility of confusion in end users .the community interest must be to put clarity on this process. MOPO/ MAPO another topic to clarify in my point of view. And all of this points are a cultural issues. we need to think globally.
