These populations include: people with disability, indigenous, aboriginal or 'first nation' populations, and other vulnerable populations (a diverse category, including groups such as refugees, trafficked and exploited people, crime victims, etc.), and ICANN as a leading organisation with particular focus and mission within the wider Internet Ecosystem is taking a proactive approach to building better and effective diversity of input and engagement in its activities, in several ways including by utilizing the experience, skill sets, and interests of many of its existing and prospective Community Members, Staff and External Consultants in the activities of this Cross Community Committee on Accessibility, as we:
