Nathalie Peregrine:Dear all, welcome to the PPSAI WG call on the 2nd September 2014 at 14:00 UTC

Nathalie Peregrine:Hello Holly, dialing out to you now

Holly Raiche:Thanks

Tobias Sattler:Hi there

Chris Pelling:good afternoon all

Graeme Bunton:G'morning all

Kristina Rosette:Greetings. Apologies for being late.

Amr Elsadr:Hi. Dialling in now.

Nathalie Peregrine:Amr, attendance noted

Amr Elsadr:Thnx. :)

Nathalie Peregrine:Susan Kawaguchi has just joined

Nathalie Peregrine:Phil Marano and Vicky Scheckler are on the call

Nathalie Peregrine:Jim Bikoff is also on the call

Nathalie Peregrine:Paul McGrady is in the Ac room

Graeme Bunton:Nope!

Nathalie Peregrine:Griffin Barnett is also on the call

Nathalie Peregrine:Libby Baney has joined the room

Graeme Bunton:someone's mic needs to get muted

Mary Wong:Please mute your mics unless you're speaking - thanks!

Graeme Bunton:vigorous typing

Frank Michlick:who is typing next to their mic?

Chris Pelling:still typing :p

Nathalie Peregrine:Kathy Kleiman is on the phone bridge

Nathalie Peregrine:Operator is trying to isolate typing noise

Nathalie Peregrine:please all mute mics

Nathalie Peregrine:and phones when not speaking

Chris Pelling:this quality of call today is pretty poor

Chris Pelling:lots of clicking

Amr Elsadr:I'm sorry. I haven't gone through this document yet. Trying to read it now.

Nathalie Peregrine:@Chris, I'm on the phone bridge, but do not hear clicking

Nathalie Peregrine:would you like us to dial out to you to improve your line?

Amr Elsadr:I can hear the clicking too.

Nathalie Peregrine:ok let me see what the operator can do, as I cannot hear it.

Volker Greimann:the clicking is clearly audible on the Adobe audio bridge

Volker Greimann:now it is gone

Chris Pelling:Nathalie, no - but I was not the only one hearing it and it was annoying - right now it's gone, thanks

Mary Wong:Following up on Kathy's question - the NCSG's suggestion regarding considerations of anti-competitive activity and small business challenges is listed under the question relating to Safeguards (in this new document, Section II Question 3.)

Graeme Bunton:Often both, Steve

Libby Baney:I've heard use of the phrase "legitimate" request, and evaluate "on its merits." It is unclear to me what those terms mean. Where are they defined? Is it the charge of this group to establish the standard?

Volker Greimann:Difficult. Currently, our review gives us the necessary leeway to make a case-by-case decision.

Amr Elsadr:Is it practical to try to standardize what is a "legitimate" request? Couldn't that vary according to the jurisdiction the P/P provider exists in?

Chris Pelling:All notices into us are case by case, you cannot mask it down to a set of rules as things will fall through the cracks

Vicky Sheckler:in considering legitimate request, need to consider jdx of complainant as well

Chris Pelling:phone crackling is back

Holly Raiche:@ Chris - I think that was my question - how hard will it be to understand baseline situations of disclosure

Nathalie Peregrine:Operator is working to isolate the line

Nathalie Peregrine:please all mute phones and AC room mics when not talking

Amr Elsadr:Does minimum standard = standard? I don't think so. A minimum standard would be required, but may not actually warrant a reveal. A strict standard would, wouldn't it?

Chris Pelling:very good point Kathy

Volker Greimann:we are back to the cracking noise on the Adobe bridge

Paul McGrady:Sounds is going in and out.

Nathalie Peregrine:we're working on it

Nathalie Peregrine:Working

Graeme Bunton:I'd have to ask compliance for a concrete answer

Volker Greimann:Addition: Anonymous complaints go directly to the bin. No response, no recourse!

Chris Pelling:gone all quiet

Nathalie Peregrine:There is no issue with the AC audio, someone on the phone line was creating static, that person has now been muted and informed.

Chris Pelling:ill take my hand down

Chris Pelling:UDRP is there and the UDRP service will request a reveal

Chris Pelling:its to do with the "domain" not the content though

Chris Pelling:We siggest to the registrant that they seek professional advice

Chris Pelling:@Kathy

Chris Pelling:suggest *

Chris Pelling:thank you all :)

Holly Raiche:thanks steve

Amr Elsadr:Thanks all. Very interesting discussion.
